Please complete the name request form below. For a main family header plaque, a minimum contribution of \$2,500 is required. For a secondary plaque to recognize additional family members, a minimum contribution of \$500 is required per individual name. Production lead time is approximately six to eight weeks. Name plaque production will begin once gift is received in full. The positioning of the name plaques on the Generations Wall are at the discretion of Life University.

Family members qualified to be listed on the Generations Wall must be either D.C. graduates and/or the qualified spouse or domestic partner of a D.C. graduate (only available on Option 1B).

Secondary Plaque Selection *(If applicable)*
